

FEMALE HOCKEY – GRANT APPLICATION



OVERVIEW:

The grants are designed to strengthen female hockey programming, with a particular focus on three areas: Athlete Experience, Leadership, Promotion. The primary objective is to achieve growth in the female game at every age group and level of play for players, coaches, and support staff.

ELIGIBILITY:

Female Hockey Associations, Female Hockey Leagues and co-ed Associations that are operating all-female programs are eligible to apply for this grant.

Applicants must demonstrate their capacity to plan and implement programs in at least one of the following areas:

ATHLETE EXPERIENCE	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Recruitment initiatives / try hockey programs.• Creation of 'female travel teams' in rural areas (start-up costs may include jerseys, ice-time, etc).• Creation of all-female programs in each division• Development opportunities for participants (specialized coaches, professional development, education)• Equipment (gear sharing for goalie equipment, training aids, etc)
LEADERSHIP	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Professional Development opportunities for Coaches and Officials• Recruitment initiatives for Female Coaches and Officials
PROMOTION	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Promotion of female programs (signage, websites, etc)• Showcase tournaments and events• Jamborees

DESCRIPTION:

The application form must be completed. Deadline to apply is **September 1st, 2023**.

The successful applicants will be required to submit a summary of their event / initiative within 30 days of the event or initiative concluding.
