AA – for every 60 players, the association must have a AA team

A – 24-59 players	
<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Discretion is provided + / - 10• The above numbers represent the requirement to have A and AA teams.• Additional teams are at the discretion of the association.	
a. U11 AA teams can be formed between neighbouring associations with the approval of the Board of Directors from each association as well as the District Director.	
b. Minor Hockey Associations can make a request to their District Director at the start of the season to play at the highest level without meeting the required numbers.	

- c. Minor Associations may register more than one team in the same classification within a division. These teams must be balanced.
- d. If a player's home association does not offer U11 AA, the player can transfer to a neighbouring association. If they do not make the team, they must return to their home association.
- e. It's recommended that associations have no less than 50% of their teams at the recreational level.

For upward player movement to competitive division:

Registered non-AAA co-ed teams shall adhere to the following criteria with respect to the use of underage players in any division of minor hockey:

a. The upward player movement shall be available for second year players beginning in U9 including exceptional players with the movement to Competitive C or above with approval of District Director. Players in their second year of a division are eligible to be evaluated for player movement. For player movement from U9 to U11, players must rank in the top half of players on a U11 'Competitive Team'. For player movement from U11 to U13, U13 to U15

and U15 to U18, players must rank in the top third of the highest category team in the next division or club.

For player movement related to AAA, please refer to the EHC Exceptional Player Status Guidelines.

b. Overall hockey ability.

c. Physical development.

d. Social development.

e. The Selection Committee must be independent of the coaching staff of the team and must be made up of a representative of both the NBMHC and NBEHC, or their representatives.

f. All players (aged and under-aged) must be evaluated objectively and ranked by the Selection Committee.

g. The District Director from whose area the under-aged player is coming, must approve the selection and file same immediately with the Executive Director.

h. The use of the player must remain consistent with this ranking during the playing season or his status may be revisited by the District Director responsible for his league.

i. To balance program requirements of the association/club.

j. A fee of \$250.00, payable to the Hockey New Brunswick District.

k. All requests for upward player movement must be received by September 1.

For upward player movement to recreational division

Players must roster within their appropriate age division unless permission is granted by their District Director for a second year 'C' ~~or Female A~~ player to move up one division within the 'C' ~~or Female A~~ level. The District Director shall use the "Risk, Safety and Conduct Management" criteria for determining such movement.

For downward player movement (female players playing co-ed):

At the discretion of the district director, female co-ed players may be permitted to play down one division and play at the ~~co-ed competitive level, the~~ co-ed "C" level ~~or the female A level~~. Each request is reviewed on a case-by-case basis and the District Director shall use the following criteria for determining such movement: a. Risk and safety management. b. Medical. c. Compassion d. Development of the player.

First year Female players may play down one division in a co-ed competitive division if they reside in a district that does not have a female competitive team.

~~Female players must rank in the top 50% of the competitive team at the lower level. Once the overage female player is approved on the roster, they are permitted to participate in provincial playoffs, and all HNB sanctioned events. Participation in tournaments outside of New Brunswick would be at the discretion of the tournament organizing committee.~~

For downward player movement (male players):

At the discretion of the District Director, male players may be permitted to play down one division and play at the co-ed “C” level. Each request is reviewed on a case-by-case basis and the District Director shall use the following criteria for determining such movement: a. Risk and safety management. b. Medical. c. Compassion d. Development of the player.

The player must be evaluated to be in the bottom 50% of players on the lower category team that the player is to be rostered to. Once the overage player is approved on the roster they are permitted to participate in provincial playoffs.
