### **Criteria to apply for an HNB Scholarship:**

- Applicant must have been a Hockey New Brunswick member or associate member in the 2019-2020 hockey season (HNB player, NBIAA player or HNB Official).
- Applicant must be under the age of 21 as of December 31<sup>st</sup> of the current season.
- Applicant must be graduating or must be a graduate who is pursuing post-secondary studies in 2020-2021.

### **How to Apply:**

- Applicant must send a 300 to 500-word essay (double-spaced) to the Selection Committee outlining their community involvement, as well as financial need. The essay should explain how hockey has impacted their life.
- Provide a most recent record of academic transcript
- Provide an athletic resumé (outline sports involvement by year)
- Proof of post-secondary education acceptance letter
- Please include a photo of your choice with your completed submission

**\*Incomplete applications will not be considered. Please ensure your application is complete and includes all required components at the time of your submission.**
